If you are using one of our Pfaff machines, we ask that you arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled class starts to get the machine ready and you will need to bring (buy) 2 bobbins for the machine. Please bring along all other quilting tools and accessories required for your class.

Class Policies and Notes

Registration is complete with the payment of fees (plus GST), first come basis. Registration fees are fully refundable up to 14 days prior to the scheduled class. If it is necessary for you to cancel your class after that date, an in-store credit will be issued for cancellations up to the 24 hours BEFORE the class is scheduled. Requirement sheets and pre-cutting instructions (if required) will be available for pick up 2 weeks before the class.
